- All inmates of girls' and boys' hostels shall be instructed not to involve in any kind of ragging(physical and mental) among themselves and particularly not to harass(teasing, psychological harm or handling with rudeness) the new students.
- That, to generate an atmosphere of discipline by sending a clear message that no act of ragging and harassment shall be tolerated and to see any act of ragging shall not go unnoticed and unpunished.
- 5. That, those found in guilty of ragging in the campus or even outside the campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishment:
 - i. Debarring from appearing in any sessional test / University Examination,
 - ii. Withholding the results,
 - iii. Cancellation of the admission,
 - iv. Suspension from attending the classes and academic privileges,
 - v. Suspension from college.
