



**PROCEEDINGS OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING
ON 30.09.2018 at 11.00 a.m.
PRANANATH AUTONOMOUS COLLEGE, KHORDHA**

The Principal Dr. Bidyadhar Behera while presiding over the meeting welcomed all the members of the Council. He highlighted on the status of the college (NAAC 'A' level in Accreditation Cycle-II, CPE) and appealed for viable suggestions from the learned members to prepare a framework of the actions to bring changes so that the college scales greater heights of excellence. This will also pave the way for converting this college to a University. He focused on an innovation-integration approach to revitalize the system.

The minutes of the last meeting were presented by Dr. Nanda Kishore Biswal, Prof. I/C, UGC. This provoked intervention from Prof. Ranjan Kumar Bal's side who suggested that Academic Council meeting should be made an Annual feature which should sit ideally in June-July i.e. before the commencement of a new academic session, so that action can be taken on the suggestions of the Academic Council. The Board of Studies meeting should precede the Academic Council Meeting so that the deliberations made can get the approval of the Council.

(Action – Controller of Examination)

The minutes of the Academic Council should always be accompanied with Report (ATR) and needs to be circulated among members in soft copy prior to the meeting. The notice should be given 2 days in advance. He hoped that all this would be implemented from the next session.

(Action – UGC Coordinator)

The results of 2016-17 and 2017-18 were ratified.

The Controller of Examinations Dr. Debabrata Mohanty said that CBCS pattern cannot be fully implemented as there is a shortage of faculty and funds. The proposal for e-examination & e-evaluation was accepted with the go-ahead signal was given. The suggestions from Prof. Maheswar Sahoo & Prof. Ranjan Bal were that the modalities in regard to this have to be worked out at our level. The examination section can call for questions online with a designated ID and security code from the question setters and select one set. On the proposal over bar coding of answer scripts opinions were it was desirable but not practicable. However, it can be explored and shall be taken as an innovative practice. The entry of marks in mark foils and tabulations thereafter can be done online.

Regarding rechecking of answer script by the students themselves in the classrooms the rule place. The Controller is well within his discretion to take action on it. Prof. Smrutiprava's suggestion was that there would be no problem if the practice of displaying the internal marks in Examination notice board before sending for tabulation which is in practice in Ravenshaw is followed here. The pattern of question to be set for term-end examinations can be discussed with the students.

Prof. Bal suggested to take help of Dr. Gopal Nayak, Director IIIT, Bhubaneswar for a Software on Examination Reforms. He also focused on the Governance Project of World Bank which is a foolproof secured system. Dr. Nayak should be invited for an interactive seminar on this package. (Action - UGC/IQAC)

It was resolved that the Travelling Expenses of the Controller of Examinations be raised to Rs.25000/- and it is to be in conformity with the University rules and regulations. It was approved. (Action - Accounts Section)

In regard to holding of Students' Seminars if be reflected in the time table earmarking the day convenient to the respective departments. Further it was suggested that research methods and style of seminar presentation can be discussed in the classes. For project submission, the marks shall be divided as 70 for project writing and 30 for viva-voce. (Action - Examination Section, Heads of Departments)

Intervening in the discussions Dr. Pravati Kumari Moahapatra from the department of Zoology, Utkal University suggested that science departments are on with practical classes and have put in place the style of presentation. Prof. Bal suggested that Humanities and Commerce can go ahead to create practical classes and this college can be the first in Odisha in introducing such an innovative curriculum development.

(Action - Deputy Controller of Examinations)

Add-on courses presented by the departments were accepted and it was resolved that the Principal and heads of departments along with the UGC have to finalise the details. Looking at feasibility of such course like career placement. On the suggestion regarding an innovation hub by the Principal for enhancing emotional Quotient, an EQ centre, Prof. Ranjan Bal suggested that the Psychology department can take the lead for establishing such a centre. (Action - HOD, Dept. of Psychology)

Regulation of scholarships is to be done so that more and more students avail of the benefits. New scholarships can be introduced but proper management is required to avoid double deals. (Action - Prof. in charge of (Scholarship)

Counselling and placement cell has to take serious efforts for student progression towards employability and it should come up with career suggestions for courses offered. Training for entrepreneurship can be taken up for three years with the World Bank support. Prof. Debabrata Mohanty, Controller apprised of the ongoing training programme by Lenova under their CSR activities.

(Action - Prof. in charge Counselling and Placement Cell)

It was resolved to have a Professor in Charge of students' welfare to look after the issues of students. (Action - Principal)

The council suggested for health insurance cover for all students, teaching and non-teaching to be done by a public sector insurance i.e. National Insurance Company or any other can be contacted for the purpose so that it will not attract any audit objections. (Action - Principal)

The following matters were discussed and approved. The two student representatives expressed their concern for purchase of new books in the library according to the new syllabus. Though some departments issue relevant books from the department library it is not sufficient. It was resolved that sufficient funds shall be allocated from world bank assistance and other sources (6 lakhs among the 20 departments) in the current financial year so that this problem can be handled. (Action - Prof. in charge of Library)

Provision of books and availing of free books shall be explored subsequently.

The coordinator for World Bank, Dr. Sushil Patnaik and Dr. Pradipta Mohapatra for RUSA made a brief presentation of the different heads on which allocations are to be received by the college.

World Bank assistance of 4.4 crores for non-civil works out of which 11 lakhs have already been sanctioned this year for Library books, automation and furniture, while major component of RUSA will be for Laboratory equipments.

The council acknowledged that, as the teachers have the Power and responsibility to guide their institutions towards excellence, so teachers should be given considerable latitude to use their full potential.

A formal vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. Nanda Kishore Biswal, Prof. in Charge, UGC.

- 1) The proposed innovative practices in conducting e-examinations, e-valuation and online submission of question papers are not possible due to financial crunch. Hence, the existing system of examination shall be allowed to continue.
- 2) Special mid-semester examinations for 5th & 6th semester students (those who have not appeared) shall be conducted by depositing the requisite fees before the respective Term End Examinations.
 - 3) Model Question Bank as per State Model Syllabi (2019-20 session) shall be prepared by the department concerned for the reference of the students.
 - 4) Enhancement of remuneration relating to examination activities shall be approved by the Finance Committee of the college.
 - 5) The fees for the filling in of forms for 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th semester Term End Examinations (2018 A.B. & 2017 A.B.) shall be enhanced to Rs.600/- (Rupees six hundred only).
 - 6) The fees for the filling in of forms for 2019 A.B. and onwards shall be Rs.700/- (Rupees seven hundred only) per semester and be collected for two semesters at a time at the time of admission/re-admission.
 - 7) Faculties and students shall be informed regarding the pattern of questions. Question pattern be displayed in Students' Notice Board and awareness programme be held concerning this.
 - 8) In the Mark-sheet, the date of publication of result shall be mentioned.
 - 9) Personal Consultancy and Departmental Consultancy under extension activities shall be taken up. Department of Philosophy and Psychology shall take the lead in this regard.
 - 10) Adoption of Village under extension activities shall be taken up by Commerce stream and Department of Economics for literacy and economic development.
 - 11) The Department of Computer Science shall conduct programmes for computer literacy in respect of teaching & non-teaching staff of the college and shall provide e-resource list to all departments.
 - 12) A.Q.A.R. shall be placed in the Academic Council Meeting for approval.
 - 13) Annual audit on accounts, academics, administrative activities, gender, solar energy, green and safety shall be done between March & June every year.
 - 14) Department of Botany shall take the charge of Green audit which will come out in form of a Booklet. The World Bank shall be requested to provide assistance to Green Audit.
 - 15) Special seminars shall be organized by inviting Director, MSME for Skill Development Programme.
 - 16) The Placement Cell of the college shall provide guidance, training and assistance to students for employment. The budget for this cell shall be enhanced to Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) and there will be a separate budget for training.
 - 17) HODs shall help their students to update their skill in proctorial classes.
 - 18) Career Counseling Cell shall be re-constituted with 09 members under the headship of the Head of the Department. Psychology, HODs of English, Computer Science and Commerce shall be the members of this cell.
 - 19) Out Sourcing Agencies shall be contacted to impart training to students.
 - 20) The Departments shall promote students for higher studies.
 - 21) The members of the Academic Council (any two) shall be informed to supervise the conduct of Term End Examinations & they will submit a report to this effect.

Proceedings of the Academic Council Meeting

On 11.12.2022, At-11.00 AM

Maitree Bhawan – Pran Nath College(Autonomous), Khordha

The meeting of the Academic Council (for the session 2020-2021 and 2021-22) of Pran Nath College (Autonomous), Khordha was held on 11.12.2022 at 11.00 AM in Maitree Bhawan under the chairmanship of esteemed Principal Dr. Ajanta Satapathy. Esteemed dignitaries, Prof. K.P. Mohanty (G.B. nominee), Dr. Dillip Agarwal, Industrialist and Member, Prof. Nigamananda Dash, Director, CDC, Utkal University, Prof. Asim Ranjan Padhi, HOD, Utkal University, Prof. Abhay kumar Nayak, Registrar- NISER along with Heads of UG & PG departments, all members of IQAC, Controller of Examinations, all members of IQAC committee, all Administrative Bursars and Accounts Bursars, as well as Student representatives were present in the meeting.

At the outset, each & every member present in the meeting gave self-introduction and then Principal delivered her welcome address and described current status of the College in respect of different academic, co-curricular, extra-curricular, administrative and outreach activities as a whole and she appealed for viable suggestions from the learned members to prepare a framework of actions to revitalize the system. Dr. Bindushree Mishra (Prof. I/C UGC) read the minutes of previous Academic Council Meeting & the council approved the same unanimously. However, it provoked intervention from Prof. Nigamananda Dash(Director, CDC, Utkal University) side who suggested that the minutes of Academic Council should always be accompanied with Action taken Report (ATR) and needs to be circulated among the members in soft copy prior to the meeting and should also be presented in PPT

(Action- Controller of Examination)

The Controller of Examination Dr. Devi Prasad Pattanaik in his deliberation placed different proposals regarding +3 Autonomous Examinations and subsequently the council approved unanimously the followings.

1. The council approved the resolution of BOS Meeting for different departments held on 27.05.2022. The syllabi of different departments (UG & PG) as passed by BOS were ratified.
2. The Academic Council approved the result of 6th Semester examinations (published on 16.8.2022) for 2019 admission batch students. However, the proposal of instant examination (for 6th semester -failed students) was rejected by the members.

The syllabus of 12 Add-on courses were approved by the council subject to a minor modification that each course should be at least of 30 hours duration. For imparting the course module, outside experts may be preferred. The college may issue certificate in favour of a student who could successfully complete the said course with 40% minimum score.

- 4 Revised payment structure/ slab (Autonomous examination - as passed by finance committee- dated 18/3/2021) related to remuneration of examiners, question setters, invigilators, CA, DA, contingency expenditures etc. was placed by the Controller and the Council approved the same.
- 5 Syllabi for newly opened P.G. programme like Chemistry, Botany & Zoology were approved by the Academic Council.
- 6 On enhancement of examination fee, the council suggested marginal fee hike year-wise instead of sharp surge at a time. This is only for minimizing extra financial burden on the students/ parents.

(Action-Prof. I/C, UGC)

Prof. I/C, UGC Dr. Bindushree Mishra proposed various matters relating to enhancement of academic excellence which were subsequently approved as follows

- 1 The Academic council approved the proposal for opening of UG courses in Statistics and Sociology along with PG courses in Economics, Political Science, English, Odia, Mathematics and Physics. It was suggested by Prof. Nigamananda Dash that college may place the proposals before befitting authority through proper channel.
- 2 Regarding the merger of PG & existing UG departments of the concerned subject, the Council suggested that HOD of UG department may be the coordinator for PG classes/examinations/other activities. However, as suggested by Prof. Abhaya Kumar Nayak, a SOP should be designed for the smooth functioning of the academic & administrative related affairs with a proper guideline for the HOD/ Coordinator to act as such.
- 3 To promote research activities, Prof. Dr. Nigamananda Dash Intervened in the discussion and suggested that the college may put forth a proposal to Utkal University/ Govt. for declaring Pranath College (Auto), Khordha as a place of research. The college should form a research committee and specific fund allocation may be made

For making this college as an Incubation Center, a specific procedure with financial involvement should be sketched. Its justification and benefits should be defined properly. As suggested by Prof. Dr. Dillip Kumar Agarwal, NISER is competent enough to provide required help in this regard.

- 5 The Council approved the proposal for introducing NCC as an elective course. The college may seek necessary permission from Utkal University for the said purpose through proper official guidelines.
- 6 The Council approved energy audit / gender audit / academic audit/environment audit / other audit reports which were obtained through due procedure for the academic session 2020-21 .
- 7 Proposal for Institutional assessment by NIRF may be prepared and sent to the appropriate authority.
- 8 For the introduction of different skill-oriented Courses (Performing Art / Dance / Music/ playing of musical instruments etc.) the Council gave green signal to go ahead in this direction through which the college may evolve as a cultural hub in near future.
- 9 A proposal may be sent to Utkal University for necessary reduction of 60% mark constraint to 50% in favour of a 6th semester student for preparing project instead of keeping 100marks theory paper (as DSE - IV) in his/her final semester.

Action- Prof. I/C, Counseling and placement, Co-ordinator World Bank (OHEPEE)

Dr. Priyabrata Mohanty (Reader in Chemistry). explained details of Career Counseling & Placement Cell activities. The Council suggested for keeping data of the students those are getting placement in different companies/ organisations/ agencies by collecting their offer letters & other relevant documents. Dr Mohanty also described details of World Bank (OHEPEE) assistance received by the college and its utilization.

Action- Co-ordinator, RUSA

Dr. Pradepta Kumar Mohapatra (Reader in Physics) reported to the house the details of RUSA grants that received by the college during the period 2020-21 and its utilization for different academic / infrastructural development works.

- 6 Major K. P. Mohanty (G.B. nominee) proposed to organize more state level seminars & workshops. He also suggested all HODs to arrange Alumni Meet and Parent- Teacher meet in monthly-basis and obtain periodical feedback from them for necessary rectification in existing teaching-learning process.
- 7 Prof. Nigamananda Dash (Director, CDC, Utkal University) suggested the college authority to encourage faculty members to avail financial assistance from different organizations to undertake Major / Minor research projects.
- 8 Prof. Asim Ranjan Padhi (HOD, English - Utkal University) urged for a vibrant Language Laboratory. He proposed to invite eminent professors from Utkal University and other leading institutions for encouraging students towards literary activities and to uplift their soft skill.

The Council hoped for greater responsibility of teachers to lift the institution to a greater height of excellence
