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PROCEEDINGS OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING ON 30.09.2018 at 11.00 a.m. PRANANATH AUTONOMOUS COLLEGE, KHORDHA

The Principal Dr. Bidyadhar Behera while presiding over the meeting welcomed all the members of the Council. He highlighted on the status of the college (NAAC 'A' level in Accreditation Cycle-II, CPE) and appealed for viable suggestions from the learned members to prepare a framework of the actions to bring changes so that the college scales greater heights of excellence. This will also pave the way for converting this college to a University. He focused on an innovation-integration approach to revitalize the system.

The minutes of the last meeting were presented by Dr. Nanda Kishore Biswal, Prof. I/C, UGC. This provoked intervention from Prof. Ranjan Kumar Bal's side who suggested that Academic Council meeting should be made an Annual feature which should sit ideally in June-July i.e. before the commencement of a new academic session, so that action can be taken on the suggestions of the Academic Council. The Board of Studies meeting should precede the Academic Council Meeting so that the deliberations made can get the approval of the Council.

(Action - Controller of Examination)

The minutes of the Academic Council should always be accompanied with Report (ATR) and needs to be circulated among members in soft copy prior to the meeting. The notice should be given 2 days in advance. He hoped that all this would be implemented from the next session.

(Action - UGC Coordinator)

The results of 2016-17 and 2017-18 were ratified.

The Controller of Examinations Dr. Debabrata Mohanty said that CBCS pattern cannot be ful implemented as there is a shortage of faculty and funds. The proposal for e-examination & e-valuati was accepted with the go-ahead signal was given. The suggestions from Prof. Maheswar Sahoo a Prof. Ranjan Bal were that the modalities in regard to this have to be worked out at our level. 7 examination section can call for questions online with a designated ID and security code from the question setters and select one set. On the proposal over bar coding of answer scripts opinions were it was desirable but not practicable. However, it can be explored and shall be taken as an innova practice. The entry of marks in mark foils and tabulations thereafter can be done online.

Regarding rechecking of answer script by the students themselves in the classrooms the rule place. The Controller is well within his discretion to take action on it. Prof. Smrutiprava I suggestion was that there would be no problem if the practice of displaying the internal marks i Examination notice board before sending for tabulation which is in practice in Ravenshaw is fol here. The pattern of question to be set for term-end examinations can be discussed with the su (Action - Controller). utonoinus

Prof. Bal suggested to take help of Dr. Gopal Nayak, Director IIIT, Bhubaneswar for a Software on Examination Reforms. He also focused on the Governance Project of World Bank which is a foolproof secured system. Dr. Nayak should be invited for an interactive seminar on this package. (Action – UGC/IQAC)

It was resolved that the Travelling Expenses of the Controller of Examinations be raised to Rs.25000/- and it is to be in conformity with the University rules and regulations. It was approved. (Action – Accounts Section)

In regard to holding of Students' Seminars if be reflected in the time table earmarking the day convenient to the respective departments. Further it was suggested that research methods and style of seminar presentation can be discussed in the classes. For project submission, the marks shall be divided as 70 for project writing and 30 for viva-voce. (Action – Examination Section, Heads of Departments)

Intervening in the discussions Dr. Pravati Kumari Moahapatra from the department of Zoology, Utkal University suggested that science departments are on with practical classes and have put in place the style of presentation. Prof. Bal suggested that Humanities and Commerce can go ahead to create practical classes and this college can be the first in Odisha in introducing such an innovative curriculum development.

(Action - Deputy Controller of Examinations)

Add-on courses presented by the departments were accepted and it was resolved that the Principal and heads of departments along with the UGC have to finalise the details. Looking at feasibility of such course like career placement. On the suggestion regarding an innovation hub by the Principal for enhancing emotional Quotient, an EQ centre, Prof. Ranjan Bal suggested that the Psychology department can take the lead for establishing such a centre. (Action – HOD, Dept. of Psychology)

Regulation of scholarships is to be done so that more and more students avail of the benefits. New scholarships can be introduced but proper management is required to avoid double deals. (Action – Prof. in charge of (Scholarship)

Counselling and placement cell has to take serious efforts for student progressison towards employability and it should come up with career suggestions for courses offered. Training for entrepreneurship can be taken up for three years with the World Bank support. Prof. Debabrata Mohanty, Controller apprised of the ongoing training programme by Lenova under their CSR activities.

(Action - Prof. in charge Counselling and Placement Cell)

It was resolved to have a Professor in Charge of students' welfare to look a professor in Charge of students. (Action – Principal)

The council suggested for health insurance cover for all students, teaching and non-teaching be done by a public sector insurance i.e. National Insurance Company or any other can be contacted for the purpose so that it will not attract any audit objections. (Action – Principal)

The following matters were discussed and approved. The two student representatives expressed their concern for purchase of new books in the library according to the new syllabus. Though some departments issue relevant books from the department library it is not sufficient. It was resolved that sufficient funds shall be allocated from world bank assistance and other sources (6 lakhs among the 20 departments) in the current financial year so that this problem can be handled. (Action – Prof. in charge of Library)

Provision of books and availing of free books shall be explored subsequently.

The coordinator for World Bank, Dr. Sushil Patnaik and Dr. Pradipta Mohapatra for RUSA made a brief presentation of the different heads on which allocations are to be received by the college.

World Bank assistance of 4.4 crores for non-civil works out of which 11 lakhs have already been sanctioned this year for Library books, automation and furniture, while major component of RUSA will be for Laboratory equipments.

The council acknowledged that, as the teachers have the Power and responsibility to guide thei institutions towards excellence, so teachers should be given considerable latitude to use their fu potential.

A formal vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. Nanda Kishore Biswal, Prof. in Charge, UGC.

- 1. The council approved the resolution of BOS Meeting for different departments held on 27.05.2022. The syllabi of different departments (UG & PG) as passed by BOS were ratified.
- 2 .The Academic Council approved the result of 6th Semester examinations (published on 16.8.2022) for 2019 admission batch students. However, the proposal of instant examination (for 6th semester -failed students) was rejected by the members.

- 4 Revised payment structure/ slab (Autonomous examination as passed by finance committee- dated 18/3/2021) related to remuneration of examiners. question setters, invigilators, CA, DA, contingency expenditures etc. was placed by the Controller and the Council approved the same.
- 5 Syllabi for newly opened P.G. programme like Chemistry. Botany & Zoology were approved by the Academic Council.
- 6 On enhancement of examination fee, the council suggested marginal fee hike yearwise instead of sharp surge at a time. This is only for minimizing extra financial burden on the students/ parents.

(Action-Prof. I/C, UGC)

Prof. I/C, UGC Dr. Bindushree Mishra proposed various matters relating to enhancement of academic excellence which were subsequently approved as follows

- 1 The Academic council approved the proposal for opening of UG courses in Statistics and Sociology along with PG courses in Economics. Political Science. English, Odia, Mathematics and Physics. It was suggested by Prof. Nigamananda Dash that college may place the proposals before befitting authority through proper channel.
- 2 Regarding the merger of PG & existing UG departments of the concerned subject, the Council suggested that HOD of UG department may be the coordinator for PG classes/examinations/other activities. However, as suggested by Prof. Abhaya Kumar Nayak, a SOP should be designed for the smooth functioning of the academic & administrative related affairs with a proper guideline for the HOD/ Coordinator to act as such.
- 3 To promote research activities. Prof. Dr. Nigamananda Dash Intervened in the discussion and suggested that the college may put forth a proposal to Utkal University/ Govt. for declaring Prananath College (Auto), Khordha as a place of research. The college should form a research committee and specific fund allocation may be made

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- The Council approved the proposal for introducing NCC as an elective course. The college may seek necessary permission from Utkal University for the said purpose through proper official guidelines.

- 7 Proposal for Institutional assessment by NIRF may be prepared and sent to the appropriate authority.
- 8 For the introduction of different skill-oriented Courses (Performing Art / Dance / Music/ playing of musical instruments etc.) the Council gave green signal to go ahead in this direction through which the college may evolve as a cultural hub in near future.
- 9 A proposal may be sent to Utkal University for necessary reduction of 60% mark constraint to 50% in favour of a 6th semester student for preparing project instead of keeping 100marks theory paper (as DSE - IV) in his/her final semester.
