I am directed to say that a sum of Rs. 18,45,00,000/- (Rupees Eighteen Crore forty five Lakhs + Only) has been allotted to different Non-Government Aided Degree Colleges in two phases vide Government sanction orders under reference as Infrastructure Development Assistance during the Financial Year 2019-20. The funds so provided are to be utilized as per the following guidelines.

**The Infrastructural Development Assistance shall be utilized:-**

- For construction as well as extension of existing structure.
- For repair and renovation of the existing damaged infrastructure.
- For construction of toilet, classroom, common rooms for students and teachers, library and laboratory.
- For making provision for power supply and water supply.
- For development of college play ground and boundary wall.

It is made clear that all sorts of development works out of this fund shall be executed through the local executing agencies like PWD, RD, Municipality, Block etc by following prescribed guidelines. The College authorities shall ensure the quality of the project works and timely completion of the project. The utilization Certificate is to be furnished by 31.12.2020 failing which the grant amount shall be recovered from the college and the college shall not be considered for any grant in future.

1. Co-ordinator, RUSA shall take steps for procurement of Lab. equipments & accessories by inviting tender at the earliest.
2. Co-ordinator, World Bank shall receive 400 nos. of dual desk, 30 nos. of classroom table, 10 nos. of almirahs, 10 nos. of executive tables from the suppliers / firms against the order issued by this office to the suppliers.
3. Reminder shall be sent to B.D.O., Khordha with a request to advise his technical staff (Junior Engineer /Assistant Engineer) to take up the construction / renovation / repair work of P.K. Boys' Hostel immediately.  
Excess expenditure if any incur for the completion of this work beyond the sanctioned amount (i.e. 28 lakh) by the Govt., the same amount shall be met from the College Development Fund.
4. A sump shall be constructed for the storage of ground water so as to supply the same to all hostels round the clock. The Collector & District Magistrate, Khordha shall be intimated about this matter and be requested for financial assistance in this regard.
5. The layout for proposed stadium has been prepared by R&B division, Khordha and the work shall be taken up shortly.
6. The internal road connecting Principal's Office and the gate facing the playground shall be extended.
7. The following works shall be undertaken very soon.
  - i. Construction of Controller's Room (Autonomous Examination Section)
  - ii. Construction of Rover's & Ranger's Room
  - iii. Construction of roof over the statue of 'Mahatma Gandhi'
  - iv. Construction of roof over the Diamond Jubilee Plaque
  - v. Construction of boundary wall surrounding the New Building
8. The floor of Room No. 45 & 46 shall be tiled and the process be completed very soon.
9. Shortly painting (white & colour wash) & repairing of N.C.C. Building shall be undertaken soon.
10. Damaged door & windows shall be replaced by iron doors & windows.
11. President, G.B. & Hon'ble M.L.A. has been pleased to sanction Rs.23 lakh for the construction of 1<sup>st</sup> floor in new U.G.C. Womens' Hostel and Rs.30 lakh for the construction of Indoor Stadium from M.L.A. LAD. Excess expenditure if any required for the latter shall be met from College Development Fund.
12. A detailed estimate shall be prepared for the construction of 2<sup>nd</sup> floor in New Building Block and be placed before President, G.B. for his perusal.
13. The remaining work of the 1<sup>st</sup> floor - New Building undertaken by CPWD is in progress since the re-opening of the college after lock down. The committee requests Principal to contact Executive Engineer, CPWD, Bhubaneswar for its early completion.
