# Report on Workshop

Date: 27.01.2020

# Title: Palka - A Sign of Bravery for Right and Truth

A workshop on "Palka: A Sign of Bravery for Right and Truth" was organized on 27.01.2020 at 10.30 AM in Maitree Bhawan to celebrate the valor and spirit of the Paika rebellion. The event focused on the historical significance of the Paika uprising of 1817, led by the Paika warriors of Odisha against British colonial rule. The Paika Rebellion of 1817 was led by Bakshi Jagabandhu. He was the commander of the Paika forces in Odisha and played a crucial role in mobilizing the Paikas, who were traditional warrior communities, against the oppressive policies of the British East India Company. The revolt is considered one of the earliest uprisings against British rule in India.

Experts shared insights on how the rebellion embodied courage, resistance, and the fight for justice and truth. The workshop emphasized the relevance of the Palkas' bravery in today's struggle for human rights and societal equality. The participants were inspired to uphold the values of integrity and truth, drawing lessons from this important chapter in India's fight for freedom. The session concluded with an interactive discussion.

#### Takeaways from the Workshop on Palka: A Sign of Bravery for Right and Truth

- Historical Significance: The Paika Rebellion of 1817 was one of the earliest uprisings against British rule, symbolizing the fight for justice, truth, and freedom.
- Leadership & Courage: Bakshi Jagabandhu's leadership and the courage of the Paikas
  highlighted the importance of strong leadership in resistance movements. The faculties
  participates in the workshop thus expected to create a quality of leadership and courage
  in their students
- Relevance Today: The principles of bravery, integrity, and truth that the Paikas stood for are still relevant in modern struggles for justice and equality.
- Inspiration for Youth: The workshop inspired participants, especially faculties to uphold
  values of courage and integrity in their own lives and work for the betterment of society
  and pass on to their students during the teaching learning process.
- Cultural Pride: It fostered a sense of pride in India's rich history of resistance against colonial rule.
